

APPLICATION FOR HALF BURSARY FOR PhD STUDY AT A SOUTH AFRICAN UNIVERSITY

AIMS is offering a matching half bursary (maximum R90 000) to its recent graduates who wish to study towards a PhD at a South African university. Bursaries are only awarded under the following conditions:

- 1. That the university will pay a matching amount from its own funds or from research funds of the supervisor towards the bursary.
- 2. That AIMS approves the study programme and topic.
- 3. That the student commences the study programme within 8 months of completing the AIMS Master's programme.
- 4. That satisfactory progress reports are submitted.

The bursary is paid over three years (R40 000 on registration R25 000 in the 2nd year and R25 000 in the third year.

DOCUMENTS WHICH MUST ACCOMPANY THIS COMPLETED APPLICATION FORM:

- 1. A proposal of the intended research topic.
- 2. A letter from the proposed supervisor or department, confirming acceptance on to the programme and the awarding of a half bursary.
- 3. A brief CV of the supervisor (if the supervisor has has not previously supervised AIMS students, or is not known to AIMS).
