BURSARY TRUST AWARDS 2022

The FMR Bursary Trust has been established for the purpose of providing scholarships, bursaries and awards for music performance students in the Jazz and Classical categories.

In terms of the Trust's founding document, the following conditions apply:

- Any bursary award must be granted to an individual on grounds of objective merit or need. The Trustees have decided that the chief criterion on which awards will be based is merit. The award must be used for any tertiary studies, and proof of registration must be attached to the application documents. High school learners who foresee enrolling at a tertiary institution in 2023, also qualify.
- 2. Any award may be revoked if the individual fails to conform to its designated purposes and conditions.
- 3. The granting of the award will be made by a duly constituted committee whose decisions are irrevocable.

From all entries received, the Panel of Judges will select 3 Finalists per category who will then appear in a public performance at the Baxter Concert Hall in Rondebosch for the final round. This concert will be recorded and broadcast later on Fine Music Radio at a date to be decided upon.

- The recording should be clear, with the candidate's instrument/voice to the fore, but DOES NOT have to be studio quality. No editing is allowed.
- In the body of the email please give full details of the tracks submitted: Title, Composer and Duration

Finalists must prepare and perform a minimum of two works at the Finalists Concert on Wednesday 17th August (Classical) and Friday 19th August 2022 (Jazz) at the Baxter Concert Hall, in Rondebosch. The programme should be the same as used in the audition recordings.
