

N3TC Community Bursary Application

Please read the requirements below before completing this application.

1. This document sets out the application procedure for a Bursary from N3 Toll Concession (RF) Proprietary Limited (“N3TC”) to study at a recognised South African University.
2. Applicants must be South African citizens residing in one of the designated municipalities in the vicinity of the N3 Toll Route corridor, with **proven academic capability** and **demonstrated financial need**. Designated municipalities include: **uMngeni, Mpofana, iNkosi Langalibalele, Alfred Duma, Okhahlamba, Maluti-a-Phofung, Phumelela, Mafube or Dipaleseng**.
3. The Bursary is available to 3rd or 4th year students who are studying towards a Degree in **Civil Engineering; Accounting; Marketing; Information Technology; or Maths and Science Teaching** in 2024. Consideration will also be given to applications from students who are studying towards an **Honours** level Degree in **Civil Engineering; Accounting; Marketing; Information Technology; or Maths and Science Teaching** in 2024.
4. Limited funding is available. N3TC will, at its sole discretion, decide whether or not to accept an application and the value of award. No reasons will be given, and no correspondence will be entered into, other than a letter to advise the outcome of the application.
- 5. Applicants must have excellent academic records. Applicants should maintain an aggregate of 60% or more.**
- 6. The applicants’ fees from all previous years must be fully paid up.**
7. Bursaries are awarded for study fees and mandatory text books. N3TC will consider the merits of other costs e.g., accommodation, which if agreed to, will be offered on the basis that payment is made to the institution’s formal accommodation facilities and not directly to the candidate.
8. Bursaries will be awarded for a period of one year at a time. Any extension is entirely at the discretion of N3TC, providing always that all Bursary conditions, stipulated in the Bursary Agreement, have been fulfilled.
9. No direct payments will be made to the Bursary recipient.
10. Bursary recipients are encouraged to have a mentor to assist them in achieving satisfactory academic progress. Information regarding the proposed mentor is to be provided.
11. The Application is to be completed in block letters. Ensure that you read every section, provide complete and accurate information, and sign the Application.
12. Please be as descriptive as possible – one-word answers are not helpful and will negatively impact on the assessment of your application.

14. The **closing date** for the submission of applications is **Friday, 12 January 2024 at 17:00.**
15. **Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.**
